Dear Ms. Hanlon:

The purpose of this e-mail is to request that the Department of Energy recommend to President George Bush that the site at Yucca Mountain, Nevada be designated as the national repository for high level radioactive waste and spent fuel.

This issue has been studied for years. During this time, the nuclear industry has been safely handling, storing and transporting spent nuclear fuel, proving that the containment devices used are properly designed for this purpose. Additionally, the recent Site Suitability Evaluation presents firm evidence that the Yucca Mountain site is an appropriate location for a central repository.

For these reasons, I urge the Department of Energy to recommend the Yucca Mountain site to the President.
